Elections Goes On ...

Following the Irish Election last month with clear victory Fianna Fail, the Czechs voted left wing parties in the general election on June 14 - 15. The winner is Socialni Demokracie (Social Democrats) 30.2% followed by ODS (Civic Democrats) 24.47%, KSC (Communists) 18.51% and Koalice KDU-CSL and US-DEU (Claimed to be liberals) 14.27%. Now Social Democrats are in the process of forming coalition with KDU-CSL and US-DEU. Slovak general election will take place at the end of summer. The expected winner is Meciár's HZDS. However the people have not spoken yet.
